## **NEW ENERGY MOVEMENT BACKGROUNDER**

New Energy Movement is a California Non-Profit - 501(c)(3) - that serves as the coordinated voice of an emerging scientific renaissance.

Founded in 2004 by former Apollo Astronaut & Princeton Physics Professor, Dr. Brian O'Leary, and Eco-Activist Alden Bryant (a principle architect of the United Nations Climate Treaty), this group's overarching mission is to develop broad public awareness of unconventional energy alternatives and explore their implications for modern science.

An agenda for the reform of energy practices and policy is also central to New Energy Movement's aims.

Through international conferences and local activist groups worldwide, New Energy Movement seeks to challenge the prevailing dependence upon unsustainable energy, particularly nuclear and petroleum fuels. The group conducts, compiles and publishes studies on the trends in society (both economic and political) that have resulted in this dependence.

Heretofore unheralded advances in physics which portend the obsolescence of conventional energy sources inform New Energy Movement's conviction that fundamental change is possible. Technologies that have lingered far too long in the laboratory are being exposed to the light of mainstream scrutiny. A consensus on the nature and potential of New Energy is of the greatest concern to researchers and theoreticians engaged with the Movement.

It is envisioned that New Energy Movement will have discerned which of the emerging technologies are most promising and thus be in a position to recommend to government and industry those meriting immediate development.
